

# CALIFORNIA ENERGY COMMISSION GRANT OVERVIEW

The CEC recently announced \$10M in funding for charging infrastructure, planning and workforce training. Funds are solely available for CA Native American tribes, CA tribal organizations serving federally-recognized tribes, Federally recognized tribal governments and tribally owned businesses.

**Deadline: April 24th 11:59 p.m.**      **Notice of Award: July 2024**

## Program Details:

- All projects must be in CA and be located on or connected to tribal land and in operation for at least 6 years
- Infrastructure should support medium and heavy-duty vehicle charging
- The CEC minimum award amount is \$400k and the maximum award is 100% of total project costs or \$3M, whichever is less
- CEC will fund projects through reimbursements and projects must be completed within three years of executing an agreement with the CEC
- Fast charging station sites must include at least two DC fast chargers.
- Level 2 sites must include at least 5 Level 2 chargers

## Eligible Costs:

Electrical infrastructure, charging equipment, distributed energy resources (solar/ batteries) supporting a project's power needs, installation/ construction costs, planning/ design, project management and utility/ site upgrades.

**No match requirement.**
